CREATE @ KING'S: MONDAY 6TH – FRIDAY 10TH JULY 2026

Your child is due to take part in Create @ King's during Project Week 2026.

Students should attend school in non-school uniform during this week; however we will be working in an art environment with messy materials so **old clothing/an apron/old shirt** is advisable. **Open-toe shoes including flip flops and crocs should not be worn**, and long hair must be tied back.

Students will be able to access the Canteen as normal during break and lunchtimes.

Activities will take place in various rooms around the school site. Students will be informed of their registration venues in due course.

TIMETABLE OF ACTIVITIES:

MONDAY 6th July – Felt & Fabric Day

Students will learn to needle felt, fabric paint and collage.

TUESDAY 7th July – Paper Play Day

Students will make cards, masks, mosaics and origami.

WEDNESDAY 8th July – Clay & Sculpting Day

Students will use clay to make jewellery, sculptures and other items.

THURSDAY 9th July – Paint & Print Day

Students will print their own wrapping paper, silhouette scene, mandalas and pebble painting.

FRIDAY 10th July – Recycled Crafts Day

Students will turn trash into treasure. This will include glass painting, button art and fabrics.

Although students will have access to lots of fabulous craft materials during the week, Mrs Osbond has asked that they bring any of the following items from home:

- ✓ Glass jars – jam jars/pickle jars etc (cleaned)
- ✓ Napkins – ideally coloured with patterns/images
- ✓ Old fabric to paint and/or decorate
- ✓ Rocks / pebbles that could be decorated
- ✓ Old wrapping paper to collage
- ✓ Items that could be used for decoration – buttons, beads etc
- ✓ Ribbon / lace / trims
- ✓ Old greeting cards
- ✓ Tissue paper
- ✓ Shells
- ✓ Textured fabric for pressing patterns
- ✓ Small boxes / containers for storage
