EXETER CITY 'FOOTBALL FRENZY': MONDAY 6TH – FRIDAY 10TH JULY 2026

Your child is due to take part in Exeter City 'Football Frenzy' during Project Week 2026.

Please see below details of the five days, including equipment required and forms that need to be returned.

Activities will take place on the school astro from Monday – Thursday and finish by 3.20pm daily for students to travel home via their usual mode of transport. When onsite, students may use the school canteen or bring a packed lunch as normal. Jewellery must not be worn.

MONDAY 6th July – Dribbling

Focus on technical and movement skills, pass, and move, gates, space, and recognition.

TUESDAY 7th July – Skills & Tricks

Focus on skill corridor, panna games and king of the ring.

WEDNESDAY 8th July – Shooting

Focus on SSG's, shooting circuits, attacking in 3s and cross bar challenges.

THURSDAY 9th July – Teamwork

Focus on possession grids, waves, and variety games.

There will also be daily competitions/mini tournaments.
