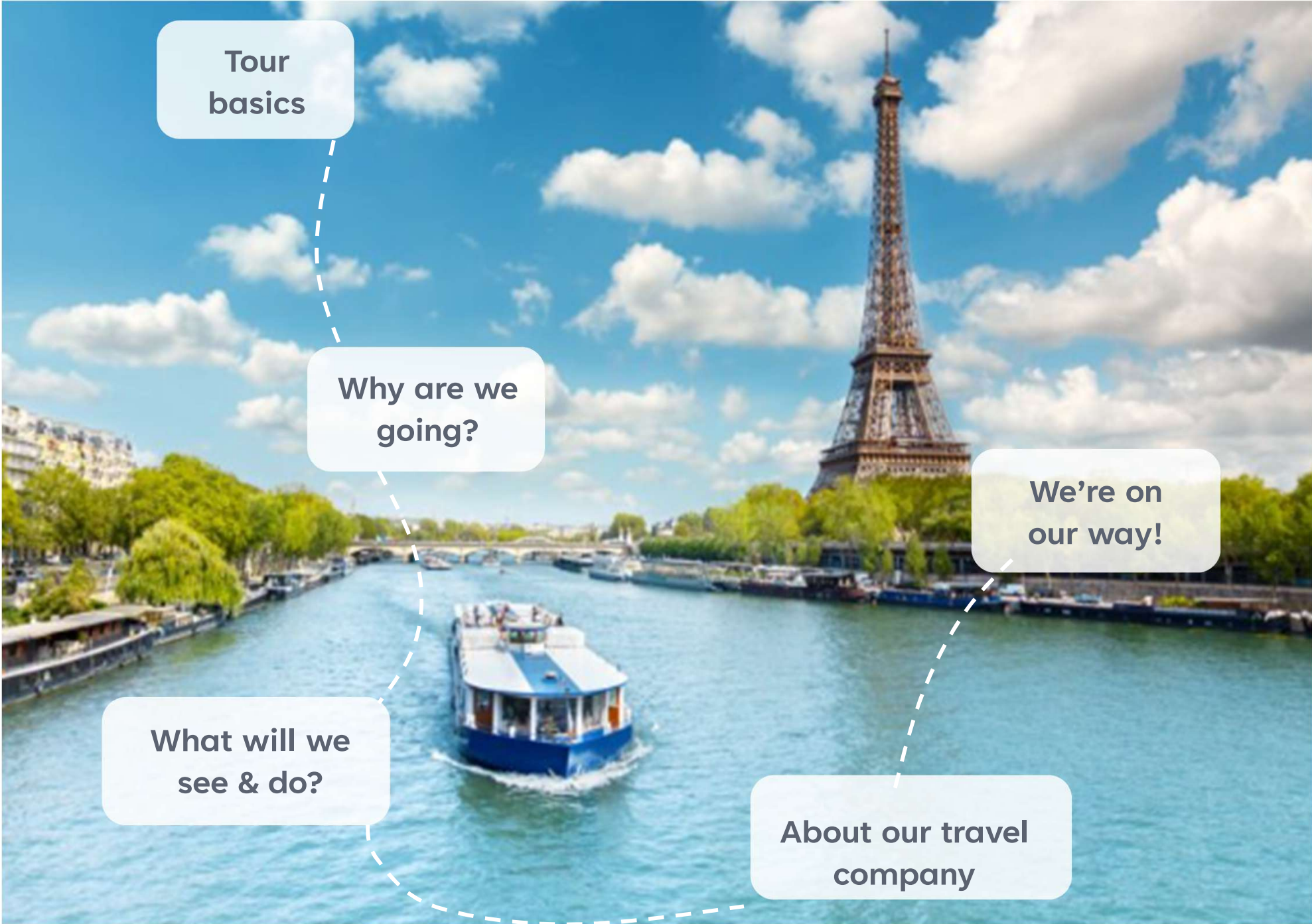

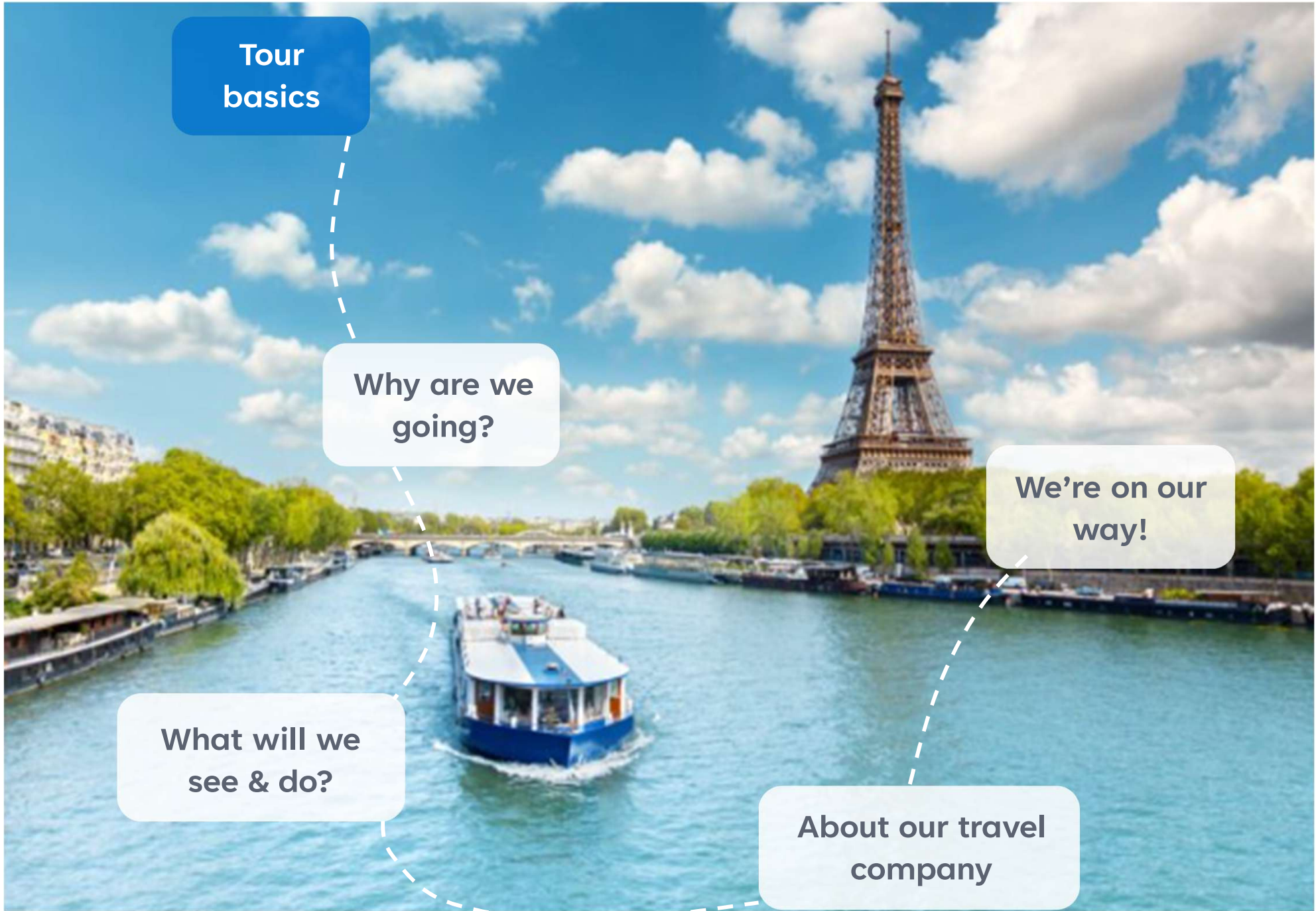

Getting there

We will depart from the Coach Park by coach on Monday 6th July at 4:00am. Please meet at school for 3:45am at the latest! We will arrive in Paris for dinner at 5:30pm.

Returning home

We will leave Paris following breakfast, at 9:30am on Friday 10th July and arrive back at school at approximately 9pm. We will send any messages if there are timing changes. **Please collect your child from the Coach Park.**

If you suffer from travel sickness, please ensure you take any medication.
Food and drink will be allowed on coach but must be kept tidy and rubbish cleared away.
To listen to music/ apps on your phone headphones must be worn.

Our accommodation

We will stay at The Explorers hotel, a short distance from Disneyland in Paris for 4 nights.

This accommodation is on a bed and breakfast board basis.

Your child has been allocated a room with one teacher supervising the room.

Each room has a bathroom (shower over the bath)
One towel per student will be provided.

The hotel has a swimming pool.

Meal arrangements

Monday – please provide a packed breakfast/lunch for journey. Dinner at Come Prima restaurant, Paris.

Tuesday – Hotel breakfast, Packed lunch (to be eaten in ‘Le Jardin de la Eiffel Tower’, Dinner at Cadet de Gascogne

Wednesday - Hotel breakfast, Packed lunch, Dinner at Billy Bobs Country Western Saloon

Thursday - Hotel breakfast, Packed lunch, Dinner within Parc Asterix

Friday – Hotel breakfast, Packed lunch provided for journey (eat well at breakfast!)

Any additional snacks and drinks will need to be paid for by the students

Disney/ Parc Asterix

- Students must stay in groups of 4 minimum
- Check in times will be given to students in the morning. They **MUST** check in within the allocated time to be able to go off by themselves.
- If there are any concerns they will have the contact details of the staff on a card on their yellow lanyard.
- Lanyards are **NOT** to be worn on rides.

Pickpockets are prevalent in Paris. Please ensure a suitable bag is used to keep their mobile phone and money safe. There are various well-known scams so please be aware.

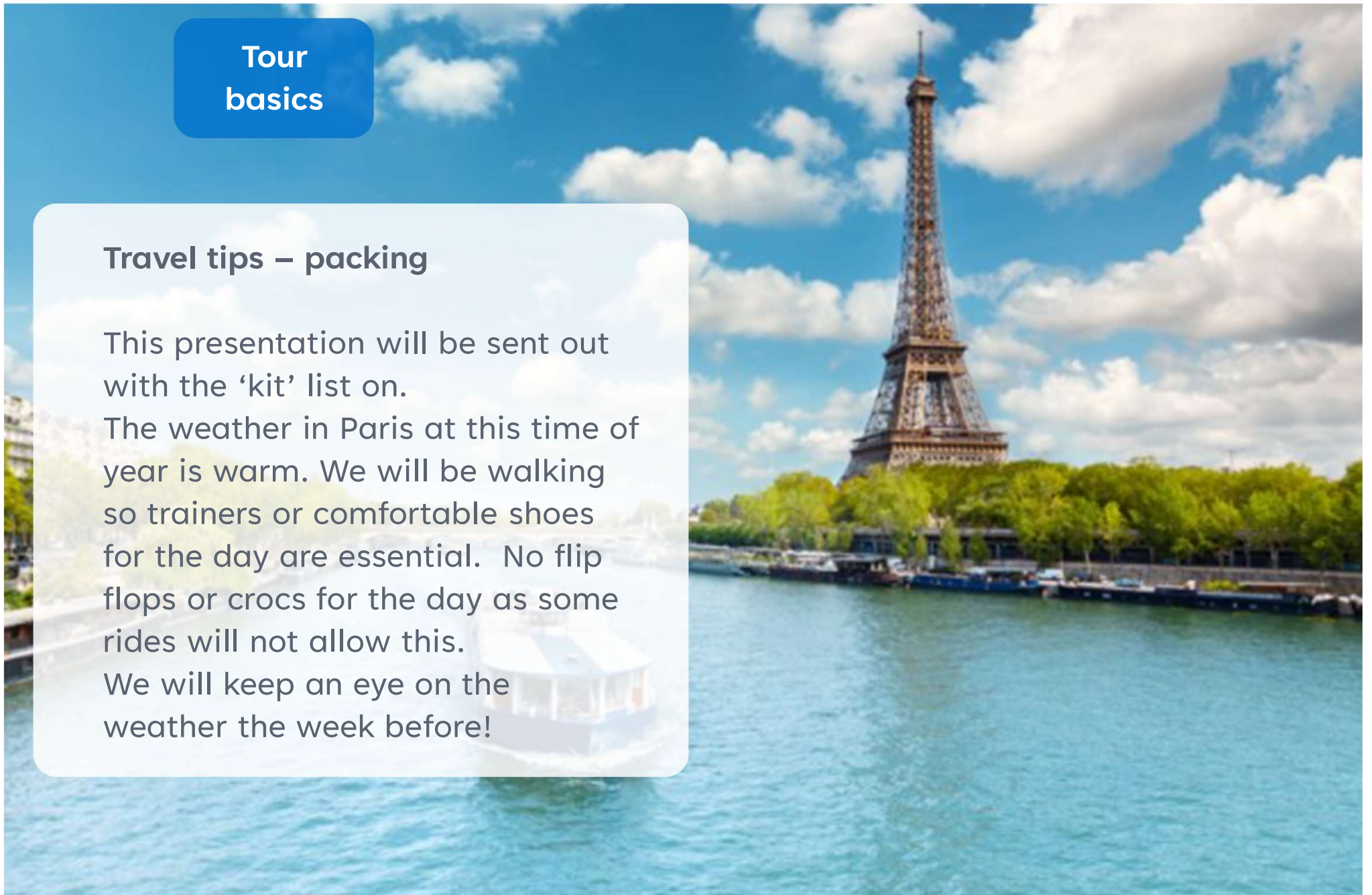

We will keep an eye on the weather the week before!



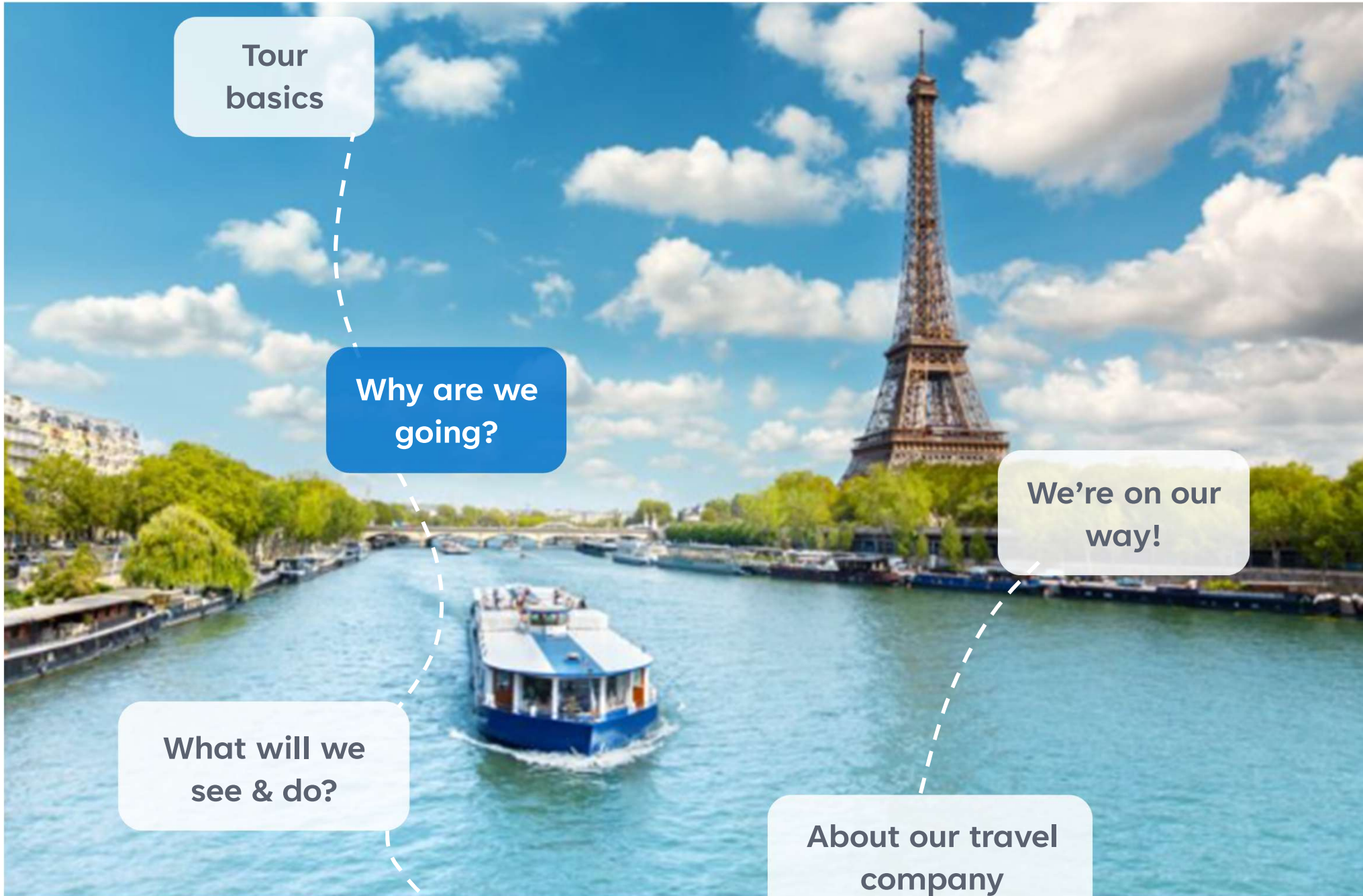

- Mobile phone/ charger/ continental adapter plug/ power bank
- Rucksack (for day trips) **Sensible bag / holder for mobile phone/ money**
- Waterproof **Comfortable clothes for 5 days**
- Trainers/ comfortable shoes
- Sun cream **Sun hat**
- Reusable water bottle
- Swimwear
- Towel (one provided by hotel)
- Sliders/ shoes for the hotel
- Wash bag **Medication** **Travel sickness tablets**

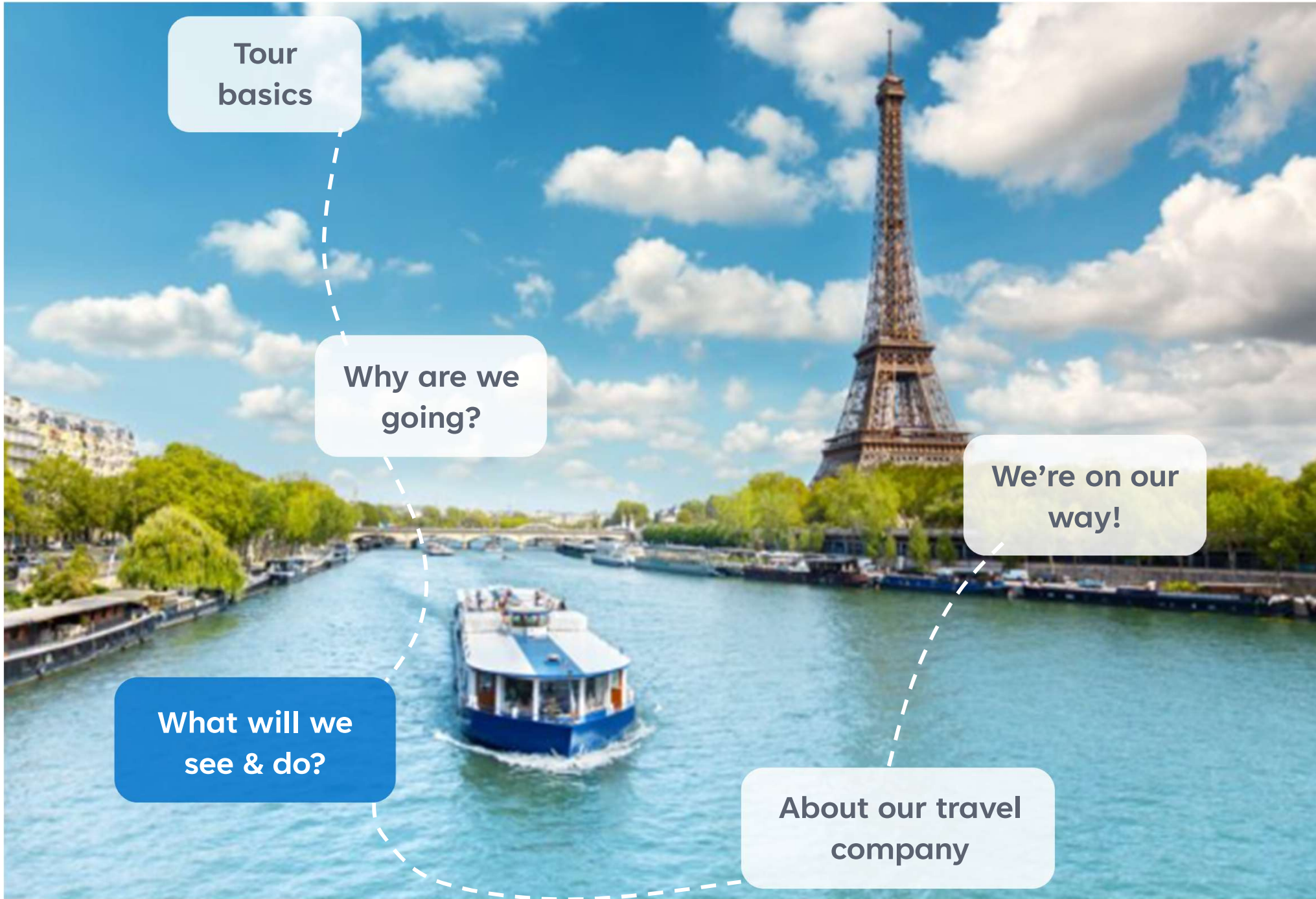



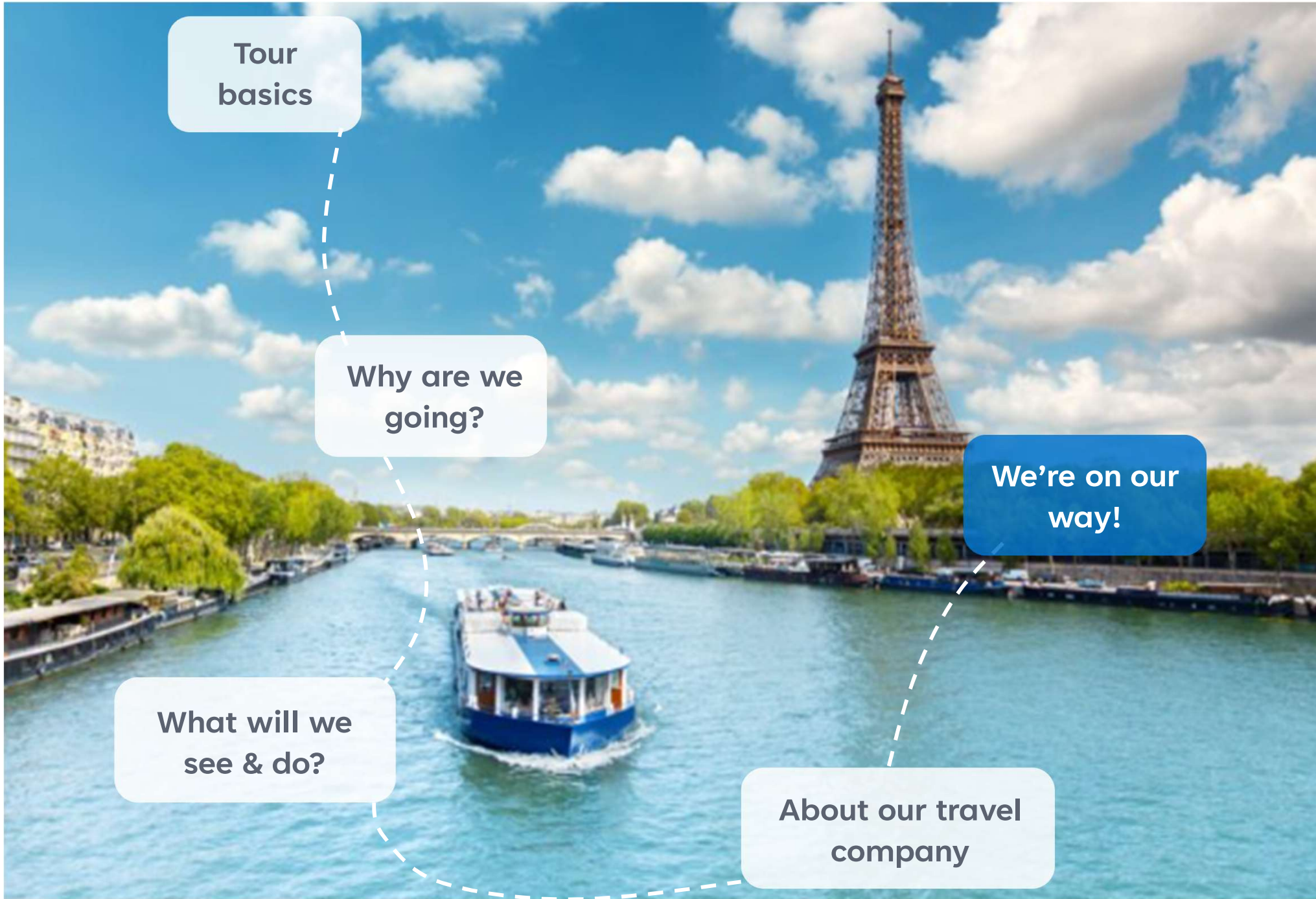

The serious stuff...

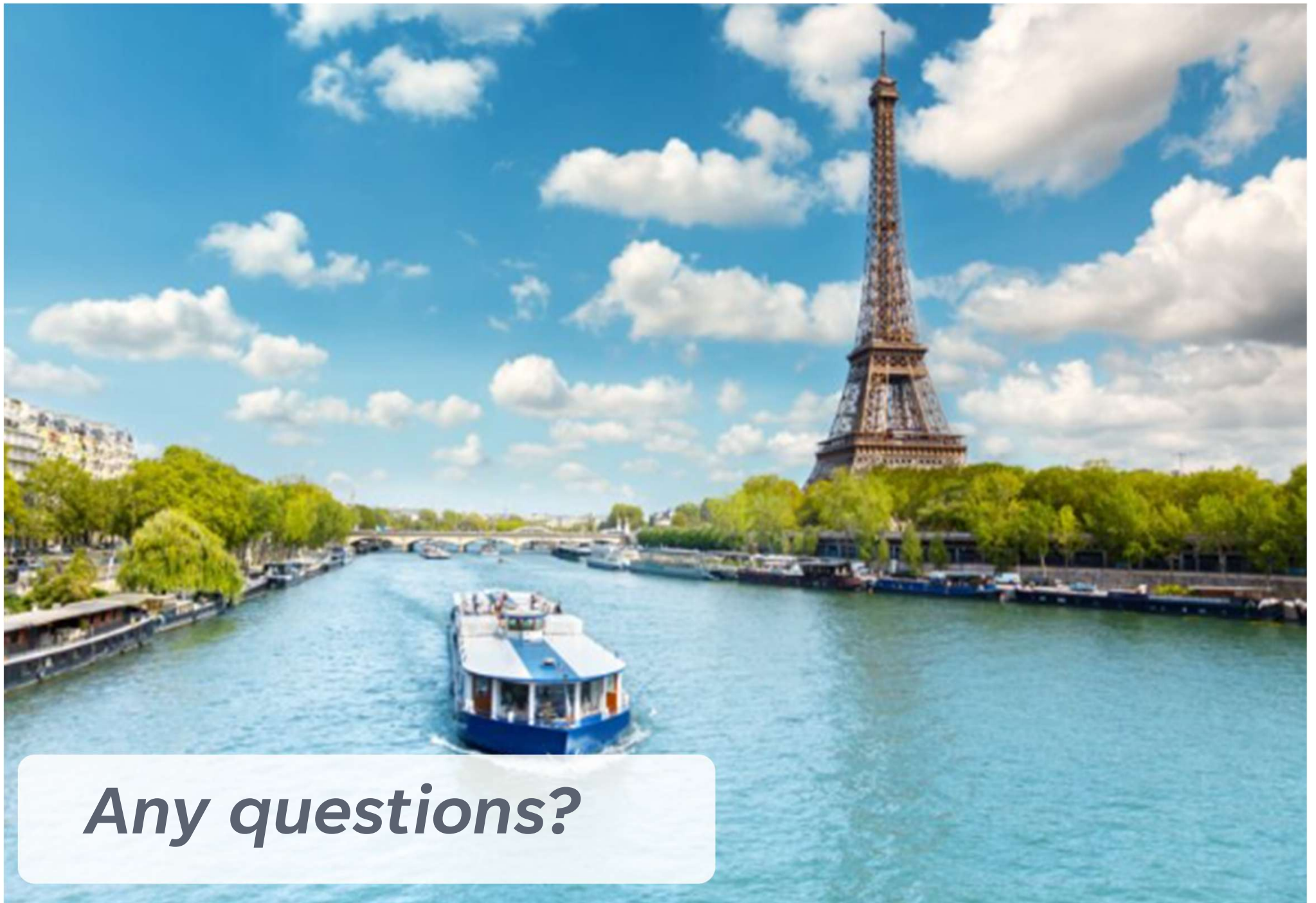
All students have signed a Code of Conduct.
