We Require...



If you, your child or a member of your household, shows any of the COVID-19 symptoms you **MUST** self-isolate as a household and get a test. Do not send your child to school.



If you are self isolating, email absence@thekings.devon.sch.uk or use Edulink to “report absence” providing the details of your self isolation. We will contact you for more details to help with our COVID-19 response.



We will ask you to wear a face covering and use hand sanitiser if you need to visit the school. Only visit when absolutely essential and by appointment only.



Ensure your contact details in Edulink are up to date so that we can contact you easily in the event of a local lockdown or child sickness.

We Advise ...



Encourage your child to safely wear a face covering in shared spaces around school when social distancing is not possible



Check that you and your child can access Edulink and that your child can use Microsoft Teams. This will be important if we send a class or year group home and need to use remote learning.



Your child should not arrive at school before 8:30am when the school gates open. This will help avoid congestion before the school gates open.

We are keeping our students and staff safe. Other schools will do things differently as every setting is different. Please respect our approach and encourage your child to follow the rules.



Please be considerate of our neighbours and local residents by dropping off and collecting in the land of Canaan car park where possible.
