16 to 19 Tuition Fund

The King's School 6th Form is using the 16-19 Tuition Fund to target and support key students who have either not attained grade 4 in their English or Maths GCSE, those who attained less than a grade 5 in one or more of their GCSE subjects, have a specific SEND need, or those who have been disadvantaged in their education by the disruption caused by lockdown. All students receiving this support and teaching are on roll as full-time students on Level 3 16-19 courses.

We have created discrete classes for GCSE English and Maths students, with 7 students receiving tuition for English and 4 for Maths - these students have one hour a week of teaching. We also have a dedicated SEN teacher who has 2 hours a week to individually mentor and develop post 16 study skills for those students who attained a result below grade 5 GCSE in one subject, or who have been disadvantaged in their learning by the pandemic. Students are selected by use of data from GCSE outcomes in 2020, and / or by referral from subject teachers and tutors. All support is delivered on 1-1 basis and tailored to the individual need of the student, with follow up if necessary.
