Results Days 2021

We are fast approaching the release of students' grades from the examination boards, based on Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs). The following arrangements will be in place for those receiving grades:

Year 13

Year 13 students may choose to collect grades in person on Tuesday 10 August from the Sixth Form Centre.

In order to reduce the number of students on site at any one time, and to allow for social distancing to be possible, we will stagger the collection of results as follows:

Surname A-H: 8.30am – 9.15am

Surname I-Z: 9.15am – 10.00am

Grades will be released to all students via Edulink at 10am.

There will be a one-way system in place in and out of the Sixth Form Centre. Students may wear a face covering as a matter of choice when collecting results. We would ask that parents remain in the playground or parking area to reduce congestion in indoor spaces. Students are asked to leave indoor venues as soon as possible after the results have been collected.

Year 12

Grades will be released to students via Edulink at 10am on Tuesday 10 August.

Year 11

Year 11 students may choose to collect grades in person on Thursday 12 August from the Main Hall

Year 10

Grades will be released to students via Edulink at 10am on Thursday 12 August.

Below are the details that apply to **all** students collecting results in person.

Parking:

Parking is available in the school car park or the coach park if necessary. The Cadhay Lane entrance and Coach Park entrance will both be open from 8.30am.

Support, Advice and Guidance:

Students' class teachers will not be present on results days and students should direct any queries to a senior member of staff on site. There will be an opportunity for independent careers advice and guidance on the day and Mr Gerry will also be available to give advice to students and parents on applications to the Sixth Form or to give advice on university offers/places as necessary.

Arrangements for Appeals

All students have the opportunity to appeal their grade if they meet the eligibility criteria. It is important to note that an appeal may result in a grade being **lowered, staying the same, or going up**. So if a student puts in an appeal and their grade is lowered, they will receive the lower mark. More information about the appeals process this summer, and the autumn examination series, is available on the school website and is detailed in a separate letter to students.
